  - A. Action on PD Construction Project

Chief Carter explained conditions and issues found in the project. 6"-12 "in places, of "dead space"/cavity under the slab, structural integrity issue, due to wash out. Structural Engineer was brought in to evaluate the situation. Option#1- Flowable fill/cement. Did not provide an estimate, however, very costly. Option #2- Remove the entire floor and redo it. Did not provide an estimate, however, very costly. Reviewed plans for the building and found to be very safe. Cell blocks have all been removed. Plan to remove a 7'x9' section (holding cell area) of floor, fill with crushed rock and pour a slab over top, to support extra weight of a new wall. In addition to the recently approved \$5000 addition to the budget, an additional \$4,950 to make the most recent structural repairs.

Mr. Belanger asked questions relating to building integrity. Chief Carter explained the plan and process.

Mr. Windover asked questions relating to materials for walls. Chief Carter explained materials.

Ms. Casey spoke of a foul odor in that area of the building. Chief Carter explained areas have been videoed for issues.
