PROOF OF RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS:

For all Transfer Station decals requested, a valid vehicle registration (or copy) must be presented. If your vehicle is not registered in Rumford, two of the following documents displaying the resident's name and Rumford address must be provided **in addition to the vehicle registration**:

- Utility bill
- Signed lease
- Property tax bill
- Automobile insurance policy
- Company letter stating that the resident has exclusive use of the vehicle.

Stickers can be issued in person at the Town Hall or via mail. If requesting by mail, mail the following to: Transfer Station Decal, Town of Rumford, 145 Congress Street, Rumford, ME 04276

- Completed application (this form)
- Copy of current vehicle registration **plus** two **proof of residency** document(s) if necessary – **see above**
- Self-addressed stamped envelope

PERMANENTLY AFFIX STICKER TO LOWER PASSENGER SIDE OF WINDSHIELD

NOTE: The Northern Oxford Regional Solid Waste Facility Transfer Station requires legal Rumford residents who are property owners to show a transfer station decal when dropping off items. Guidelines and fees for the disposal of various types of waste are available at rumfordme.org. Transfer Station stickers are available at the Town Hall at no cost to legal Rumford residents who are property owners. Please provide your registration (or copy).

If you are a tenant or a non-resident property owner you will not be issued a transfer station decal, however you may use the facility by showing a current tax bill (non-resident taxpayer), a signed lease or current State of Maine Motor Vehicle Registration (tenants) showing your Rumford address.

CLOSED ON THE FOLLOWING HOLIDAYS: New Year's Day, President's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Veteran's Day, Thanksgiving Day, the afternoon of Christmas Eve and Christmas Day

THE FOLLOWING RULES ARE IN EFFECT:

1. **NO SMOKING** in the building or around the recyclable areas.
2. **Children** (under 12 years of age) will **remain in vehicles** when within the building.
3. **No bare feet** allowed.
4. **NO LOITERING.**
5. Vehicle must have a current **N.O.R.S.W.B. decal** (available at Town Office).
6. **Corrugated cardboard, newspaper, magazines, tin cans, glass and plastics** (#1, 2, 3, 5, 6, 7) will be placed in designated areas. **Pellet bags** (clean) may be recycled by turning them inside out and placing in the recycling bag containers at Wal-Mart and Hannaford (other plastic bags also – bread, etc.).
7. **ELECTRONICS:** Cell phones, printers, DVD's, VCR players, computers, computer mouse/keyboards (subject to ongoing changes) are to be placed in the Electronic Collection Box, as are NiCad or rechargeable batteries. Tractor / car batteries to be placed in designated area.
8. **Televisions and CRT monitors** will be placed in the Hazardous Waste building for recycling.
9. All **fluorescent lights and ballasts** - give to the attendant to place in the Hazardous Waste building.
10. **Rigid plastics**, including lawn furniture and kids play toys, will be placed in designated area.
11. **Brush** must be in 8' or less lengths and placed in designated area.
12. **Wood debris** must be less than 4' or less in length, free of any metal bigger than 1" by 1" (nails, staples, spikes, small bolts and spikes are acceptable). Glass, plastic and roofing material must also be removed.
13. **ALL PRESSURE TREATED WOOD** will be discarded in the TRASH HOPPER and be 4' or less.
14. **Scrap metal and appliances** will be disposed in the designated areas. Doors must be removed from refrigerators and freezers. No junk cars or major car parts accepted.
15. **Propane tanks and cylinders** must be disposed of in the designated area – see Attendant.
16. **Leaf, garden and yard wastes** will be placed in the designated area and removed from bags.
17. **PAINT DISPOSAL:** Only "Latex" paint in a solid form will be accepted. Please open lid, let dry out or fill can with absorbent material (kitty litter/speedy dry/leaves). Oil base paint, lead base paint and stains will be accepted only during the annual Household Hazardous Waste Collection period.
18. **ALL HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE** (materials listed as corrosive or toxic) will be accepted only during the annual Household Hazardous Waste Collection period.
19. **ALL BUILDING DEBRIS** (asphalt shingles, plaster, sheet rock, etc., from remodeling and demolition projects will be charged according to following **FEE SCHEDULE**:
 - Light vehicles, passenger vans and cars..... \$15.00 per load
 - ½ ton and 1 ton pickup trucks, small trailers and 1-ton trailers..... \$25.00 per load
 - All other vehicles and containers including garbage packers, dump trucks, wheelers, pulp trucks, large trailers, roll-off containers and dumpsters..... \$16.00 per cubic yard
 - Passenger and pick-up truck tires..... \$ 1.00 per tire
 - Dump truck and wheeler tires..... \$ 5.00 per tire
20. **Fireworks** containers (used) must be soaked down with water and discarded in the trash hopper. Unused fireworks may be brought to the Fire or Police stations.
