

**WARRANT FOR
TOWN ELECTION OF NOVEMBER 16, 2020**

STATE OF MAINE, COUNTY OF OXFORD

TO: Thomas Bourret, Constable of the Town of Rumford, in said County.

GREETINGS:

In the Name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the Inhabitants of the Town of Rumford, qualified by law to vote in Town Affairs, to assemble in the MUNICIPAL AUDITORIUM, 145 CONGRESS STREET in said Town, on Monday the 16th day of November AD, 2020 at 5:00 p.m. in the evening to act on the following articles:

ARTICLE 1. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the sale of Town land, located at 1 Railroad Street and being a parcel of approximately .29 acres which is depicted as Lot 303 on Tax Map 117, with a value of \$5,100, under such terms and conditions as the Board of Selectpersons deems to be advisable and in the best interest of the Town.


ARTICLE 2. To see if the Town will vote to dispose of any rights that the Town has in a parking easement along Railroad Street and abutting the parcel of land owned by the Town depicted as Lot 303 on Tax Map 117, and which is further described in Paragraph 1 in a Quitclaim Release Deed from Rumford Paper Co. to the Town of Rumford dated October 11, 2007 which has been recorded in the Oxford County Registry of Deeds in Book 4224 at Page 96, under such terms and conditions as the Board of Selectpersons deems to be advisable and in the best interest of the Town.

ARTICLE 3. To see if the Town will vote to dispose of any rights, if any, that the Town has in a portion of Railroad Street, from the boundary of the discontinued portion of Railroad Street (as depicted on the plan named "Railroad Street Discontinuance Plan Town of Rumford Oxford County Maine" by Acme Engineering & Design dated June 29, 2007 and which is recorded in the Oxford County Registry of Deeds as Plan #4235)

to the boundary of the Hartford Street Bridge, including the Hammerhead Easement described on the aforementioned Plan and as is further described in an Easement Deed dated October 11, 2007 from Rumford Paper Company to the Town of Rumford (which has been recorded in the Oxford County Registry of Deeds in Book 4224 at Page 110), under such terms and conditions as the Board of Selectpersons deems to be advisable and in the best interest of the Town and subject to the approval of voters of the Town to discontinue this section of Railroad Street.

Notice is hereby given that the Voter Registration Office will be open during business hours at the Municipal Building on November 9 - 13 and 16, 2020 from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. to hear and decide upon applications of persons claiming the right to have their names entered upon the voting lists. The law requires all persons to show proof of identity and residency at the time of registration. The law also requires that when a voter's address changes, the voter must notify the registration office of such change.
