

Public Meeting - Road Safety for Non-motorists - Rumford

The Town of Rumford, Maine Department of Transportation and Androscoggin Valley Council of Governments (AVCOG) are looking for your feedback as part of a Vulnerable Road User Safety Assessment. A Vulnerable Road User (VRU) is a "non-motorist" which includes pedestrians, bikes, scooters, skateboards, motorized and non-motorized wheelchairs, and people using other means of "personal conveyance". A Public Meeting will be held during the Planning Board/Select Board meeting to discuss vulnerable road user safety in Rumford. This feedback is being requested to help develop strategies and shape recommendations aimed at making roadway conditions safer for vulnerable road users.

There will be a presentation of data and possible recommendations gathered so far with a focus on the opportunity for attendees to provide more information. The meeting is public and all are invited to attend and encouraged to participate.
