Chapter 56. Officers and Employees

ARTICLE I Town Auditor

§ 56-1. Duties.

The Town Auditor shall conduct an annual audit of the financial operations of all departments of the Town and of the accounts of all officials who handle funds of the Town. Such audit shall be performed in accordance with generally accepted auditing practices for municipalities and shall at least meet the minimum requirements of the general law. As soon as may be, following the close of the fiscal year, ~~the~~ Town Auditor shall make a final report covering the entire year, which report shall embody the results of ~~his~~ the Town Auditor's findings and such suggestions as ~~the~~ Town Auditor may deem advisable concerning the affairs of the Town. ~~He~~ The Town Auditor shall render such report to the Board of Selectpersons and a copy to the FinanceBudget Committee and to the State Auditor. ~~He~~ The Town Auditor shall do such other things and perform such other duties as may be prescribed by general law of the state.

§ 56-2. Irregularities.

Whenever the Town Auditor finds evidence of irregularities in the accounts of the Town or its officials, or of practices which do not comply with the general law, the provisions of the Town Charter, or these ordinances, ~~he~~ the Town Auditor shall report the same forthwith to the FinanceBudget Committee and to the Board of Selectpersons.
